CMS announced (here) a mandatory surgical demo (2026 start) in select regions of the country with minimal savings (<\$1B) expected over five years, largely from post-acute care savings. CMMI is under pressure to provide concrete savings to the Medicare program as only a handful of demonstrations (out of ~60 programs at CMMI) have saved the program dollars while maintaining or improving quality. We note that the savings come primarily from post-acute care savings versus better techniques for Medicare beneficiaries undergoing expensive surgeries.
